# **Dead Internet Theory**

## **Focus Questions**

Discuss the BTN High story as a class and record the main points of discussion. Students will then respond to the following:

- 1. Briefly explain what the `Dead Internet Theory' is.
- 2. Approximately how much of the content you see online is Al-generated?
- 3. How do you distinguish Al-generated content from human-generated?
- 4. List some risks or consequences associated with this kind of content.
- 5. What could be done to minimise Al-generated content online?
- 6. What do you think the Internet will look like in the future? Explain your answer.

### **Activities**

- In groups, discuss your online experiences with Al-generated content.
- Write a feature article about how the Internet has changed over time,
  and what it might look like in the future.
- Create a social media campaign/video to educate teenagers on how to be aware of AI-generated content online.
