We have a couple of other recent examples of ABC material being run on Sunrise, without attribution.

One is the use of an ABC graphic of the Thai cave on 9 July (6.32am).

The other is an interview on 30 June about anosmia with Jessica Kelly. The live Sunrise interview includes about 1'15 of ABC footage.
