ABC Education has produced this resource to educate Year 5 and 6 students on the Holocaust. Designed as an introductory overview, it covers the background, the sociopolitical conditions, the mechanisms of dehumanisation and persecution, and the ethical questions of what can be learned.












Hundreds of archival sources have been used, from various museums and archives around the world. This reference guide is produced to assist teachers in understanding the imagery used. Archival record titles and dates are provided, as well as the rights information. In many cases, the material is in the public domain. However, some content is licensed and cannot be reused without the permission of the originating institution.













Great care has been taken to ensure that the imagery presented is sensitive and age appropriate. No graphic imagery of atrocity is present. Examples of antisemitic propaganda are minimised and provided in an educational context. The use of Nazi-era symbols and footage are minimised and provided in an educational context.













Teachers are encouraged to view the video in full before presenting it in the classroom. The video is sectioned into chapters, giving teachers opportune stopping points for class discussion, and to break up viewing time.













URLs for each source archival record are provided – tracing these records to their original source provides an opportunity to learn more about the footage or image. ***But care must be taken*** – many of the full original films on the Holocaust contain graphic atrocity footage or imagery. ***DO NOT present archival films to students without teacher preview.***




