Under the legislation governing the Housing Australia Future Fund, the phrase "completed" can mean building, refurbishing or buying a dwelling. The story should have made clear what "completed" means, and should not have used the word "built" to describe houses bought and restored in Perth. This was an error, which led to an inaccurate headline in The Age. The online story has been amended and a clarification has now been replaced with a correction. The story will also be corrected in print editions of both The Sydney Morning Herald and The Age on Saturday, March 8 2025.
