Statement from Craig Kelly, United Australia Party:

What is the current state of these proceedings?

A "Concerns Notice" (the first step required in commencing proceedings under Australian Defamation Law) has formally been issued.

Has a statement of claim been filed?

A subsequent Statement of Claim cannot be filed with the Court until after a 28 day period has lapsed following the issuing of a Concerns Notice, but no later than 1 year after the publication of the defamatory material in question.

Do you intend to continue with your legal action against them? And, if so, when?
