



Educator Notes: Episode 9. Birds

In this episode

Birds are around us all the time, but we don't always stop to notice how fantastic our feathered friends really are! The Art Crew draw and collage beautiful birds - taking notice of their unique patterns, colours, textures and shapes.

Material Suggestions

- White art paper
- Coloured feathers
- Crepe/tissue paper

Let's extend

- Go bird watching! Head outside (with binoculars, if you have them) and look out for birds around your area. Keep a list or a collection of photos of birds you see, then find out more online via <u>Birdlife.org.au</u>
- Tropical rainforest? Nest in the grass? Hole in a gum tree trunk? Children can create a habitat for their bird artworks. Suggest children paint the environment suited to their bird, use the painting to mount and display the finished project.
- Gather fallen branches from outside and hang them high across your ceiling. Stick birds among the branches to finish the elevated display.
 Don't forget to place branches back in the outdoors after dismantling.
