Focus Questions

Discuss the BTN High story as a class and record the main points of discussion. Students will then respond to the following:

- 1. Explain the difference between gender, sex and sexuality.
- 2. Do you think it's easy for young people to be open about their identity? Explain your answer.
- 3. What challenges do LGBTQIA+ people still face today?
- 4. What significant legal changes have happened in Australia to make society more inclusive?
- 5. Why is it important to have LGBTQIA+ people represented in the media?

Activities

- As a class, discuss the importance of being respectful and inclusive of others.
- Choose an activity from <u>ReachOut Australia</u> on 'Understanding gender and sexuality'.
- In small groups, discuss and record what think it means to be an ally of LGBTQIA+ people. Refer to page 43 of Minus 18's lesson plan.
