- Use your device to record a movie with children as puppeteers and their puppets as stars of the show! Plan a movie premiere event at your centre to share the project with families.
- Do you have old rubber gloves lying around? Cut off the fingers and turn them into 'finger puppets'! Children can draw funny faces/costumes on rubber with fine tipped permanent markers.
- There are interesting videos online showing how to make and manipulate different puppet types – from carnival puppets to marionettes! Research puppet types together with children and be inspired.
