EPISODE 1

We meet Ray, recent parolee and new member of the *Black Comedy* team, encounter Thong Mum, a woman who is deadly with a thong, revisit Blakforce and the Tiddas, and meet the Beachies, a father and son who tackle the big questions.

EPISODE 2

There's a meeting to decide on a unified Indigenous language, a photo opportunity goes awry, and things get all Goodfellas with *The Elders*, an epic tale of turf war between two matriarchs feuding over the rights to Melbourne's lucrative 'Welcome to Country' income stream.



EPISODE 3

There's an advertising company trying to rebrand Aboriginality, a horror movie about silent phone numbers, the return of the Housewives of Narromine, and Blakforce SCU: Special Coconut Unit – the elite unit of detectives charged with investigating large scale crimes against Blackness.

EPISODE 4

We meet a mad driving instructor, a young mix race couple struggling to find a non-racist sexual position, visit with Uncle Doctor, a medico whose methods are more than just a little unconventional and there's the return of Brooke Satchwell's racially confused white woman Tiffany.

EPISODE 5

There's a computer that comes up with Aboriginal names, a first contact woman whose first contact has clearly made a massive impression, and we visit Wandaroorah, a little town that needs Aboriginals – and will go to terrifying lengths to get them.

EPISODE 6

In this final episode we're introduced to Maloo, a pre-settlement conspiracy theorist who's predicted the arrival of the white man, we meet a serial killer who refuses to kill based on skin colour alone and we help the Tiddas celebrate a very special event.
