



Getting Started:

Have you ever wanted to see into the past? Create your own fossil from your favourite found objects in the garden to preserve them for the future!

- Specimen you would like to fossil
- Clay
- Shallow disk
- ¼ cup plaster powder
- 70mL water

Top Tip
Get creative with your fossil and make a pattern!

What To Do:

1. Mould some play into a flat disk, a couple of inches deep and fill you disk with it.
2. Press your specimen into the clay.
3. Mix your plaster powder and water together in a bowl and mix until smooth like custard, you don't want to see any bubbles!
4. Pour the mixture over your specimen and wait until it dries, about 24 hours!
5. Peel the shallow disk away and take off the clay to reveal your fossil!
