
ABC Kids Bluey and Bingo's Easter Pouch DIY You will need:



- a brown or white paper bag
- pipe cleaners
- a fluffy pompom
- coloured paper
- coloured markers
- double-sided tape
- a grown-up to help

Bluey and Bingo's Easter Pouch

Step-by-Step



Step 1

Flatten a paper bag and cover it in your coloured paper – we used pink.



Step 2

Trim the top of the bag in a slight curved shape. Make sure you have a grown-up to help you!



Step 3

Cut out a set of ears using the pink paper for the outer ears and your paper bag for the inner ears.

We cut it all from the same paper bag. Fold the edges inwards to make them more realistic and tape them to the sides of the bag.

Step-by-Step



Step 4

Take 2 pipe cleaners and lay them in a semi-circle on a strip of paper no wider than your paper bag.

Cut a width of double-sided tape and lay it over your pipe cleaners and paper strip. Attach both handles to the inside of the bag.



Step 5

Draw on a cute bunny face to the front of the bag.



Step 6

Add a fluffy tail!
