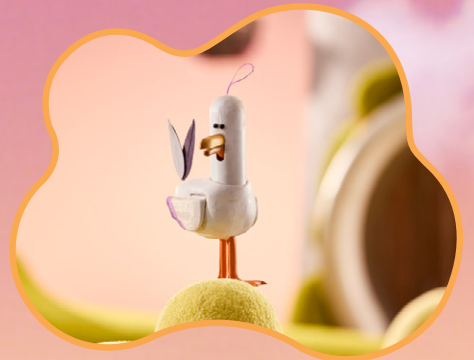

Episode 18: The Best Club in the Absolute Universe

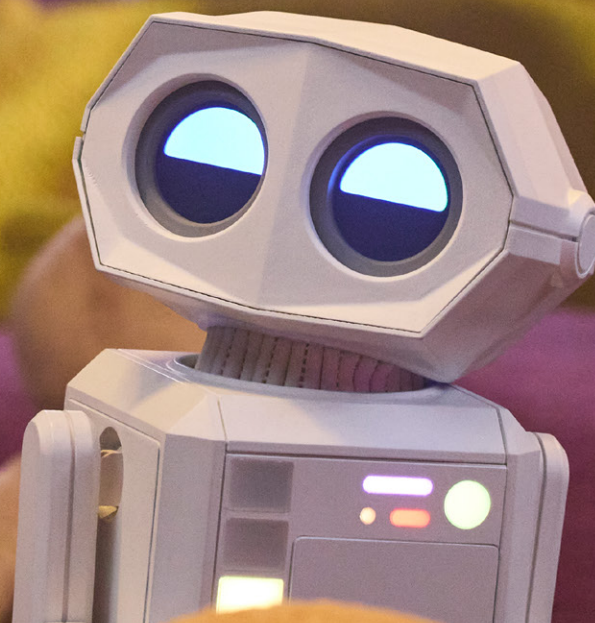
Beep, Mort and Pop decide to create the best club in the absolute universe. Now they just have to decide what their club does!
