Knitted Squares

How to guide

8 ply yarn and size 4.00 needles

Cast on 3 stitches.

Knit in garter stitch, i.e. all plain.

Increase at the beginning of every row (k2 into the first stitch). Work to 20 cm at the centre, approx. 58 stitches depending on individual tension.

Then, decrease at the beginning of every row (k1, k2 together), until 3 stitches remain.

To cast off – slip one, knit 1, pass the slipped stitch over, and tie.

Finished squares to measure 20 cm x 20 cm.

24 squares make a nice knee rug. 35 squares make a rug for a single bed. A smaller size is good as a baby rug.
