For decades there's been a **secret at the heart of working life**, hidden within vast corporations and small businesses.

When the call went out in October 2017 asking if **Australians had their own #MeToo stories**, tales of sexual harassment from ordinary women and men in workplaces across the country began flooding in. **As the number of messages climbed from the hundreds to the thousands**, it became clear that the issue was and is one of the most explosive and transformative in contemporary society.

Filed over two years, this engrossing three-part special takes us through the confusion, anger and catharsis created by **#MeToo**, encouraging conversation in our homes, schools and workplaces. The series demonstrates we are at a crossroads, with the opportunity for Australia to lead the way in **finding solutions to make our workplaces, and society, safer for all**.

Led by the stories of the **women and men who have been directly affected**, as well as their partners and families, this series **goes behind the headlines to reveal the true cost of sexual harassment** on all of us. It uncovers why there is so much confusion and backlash, and **pinpoints what can be done to make things better for everyone**.

Episode One shines a light on the issue, its impact on ordinary people, and tackles the confusion about what is and isn't sexual harassment.

In **Episode Two**, we follow as the Government responds to #MeToo with a world-first National Inquiry, and join those taking on the system. But as the momentum for change grows, so does the backlash.

In **Episode Three**, more than 18 months into the journey, the series digs deeper and explores how we can all move forward by changing the culture. We reveal how much things are shifting, at the grassroots and at the top, and discover how the next generation can help eliminate sexual harassment.
