### RE: Analysis of Material Sample for Asbestos Content "GIO Building", Gore Hill

The samples supplied by you were analysed using polarised light microscopy, with dispersion staining techniques. The protocol followed was that contained in the current draft NATA criteria on the identification of asbestos minerals in bulk materials. The detection limit under this scheme is approximately 0.1%. The results are as follows;

1. 2nd beam 1st floor entrance to mezzanine less than 0.1% 2. Centre brace (yellow) mezzanine floor less than 0.1% 3. 1st beam outside entrance to mezzanine less than 0.1% 4. Timber brace east end of mezzanine less than 0.1% 5. Roof of internal offices less than 0.1% No asbestos fibres were seen in any of the samples analysed.

BALSAN PAVILION - ROOF Subject:

I refer to the inspection held on 19/8/88 of the Balsan Pavilion Roof following concern expressed by Prod. F. Staff. Present were R. Schmidt, G. Brewer (Build. S.TV.) G. Georgeson (OH&S Mgr) and M Winser.

The roofing material was last inspected on 27/5/1986 by the National Occupational Helath & Safety Council and the roofing material was reported to be in very good condition with no cracks or chips evident and no degrading of exposed surfaces evident. At that time ABC Staff requested air monitoring as a safety measure, and measurements taken by NOH&SC showed insignificant readings. Based on this inspection the material did not require removal or treatment.

At the inspection on 19/8/88, it appeared that no change has occurred to the material since the 1986 inspection. Discussion was held re the possibility of carrying out another set of readings to verify no change in material since 1986. This can be arranged by OH&S Mgr and funded by Build.S.(TV):

It was reported that there has been some traffic on the roof by Building Services and Property Staff and contractors inspecting various roofs in the area. While this is not completely avoidable I will issue instructions to Building Services and Property Staff to minimise this traffice.

Attached is copy of the relevant section of the ABC Asbestos register (provided by OH&S Mgr) confirming the 1986 inspection details.

I would like your endorsement of the above action before proceeding to arrange tests.


### TV GORE HILL - TOWER BUILDING

This is to confirm my verbal advice of this morning that following identification of asbestos material late on Friday afternoon 1/9/89, urgent arrangements were put in place for the material to be removed by Australian Construction Services on Saturday 2/9/89.

The material was removed in accordance with the requirements for removal and disposal of such material and the work was completed early Saturday afternoon.

Due to the time of notification and the urgency of the work, we were unable to advise you on Friday and attached for your information is a report providing full details of the removal.

# GORE HILL, TOWER BUILDING FLOORS 4, 6 & 7, ASBESTOS REMOVAL - REPORT

- 1. During the current demolition and fitout of floors 4, 6 & 7, precautions have been taken to ensure that any material suspected of being asbestos is handled in accordance with approved procedures.
- 2. Several suspected items of material have been tested and verified as not being asbestos material.
- 3. Included in the items tested were some lagging materials around lengths of concealed water pipe on floors 6 and 7.
- 4. Advice was received from Australian Construction Services (Dept Admin Services) at 3.30 p.m. on Friday 1/9/89, that the lagging was 20% brown fibrous asbestos. Subsequently, at 5.00 p.m., A.C.S. advised that if immediate approval was provided the material could be removed on Saturday 2/9/89 by the A.C.S. licensed asbestos removalist specialists.
- 5. Because of the urgency and the time of notification, ACS were instructed to proceed and they removed the material on Saturday, commencing at 7.00 a.m.
- 6. The material was removed in accordance with the procedures laid down by Worksafe Australia, the C'wealth Gov't authority on asbestos removal, and included
  - sealing off of the area
  - use of approved protective clothing
  - use of approved removal techniques
  - safe disposal of removed material.
- 7. ACS have advised that all material has now been removed and disposed of. There is no other suspect material on floors 4, 6 & 7.
