EPISODE 8: CROCODILE TOURISM

Our activity sheet this week contains 4 activities, which look at the way words are linked in spoken English.

To make your spoken English sound natural you need to link words ending in a 'final consonant' sound to words with an 'initial vowel' sound.

ACTIVITY 1
