## Response from an Australian Press Council spokesperson:

"The Council received a very small number of complaints about the article. It is not the Council's policy to provide details of the dates complaints were received nor of the stages of complaints handling. The Adjudication was made in accordance with the Press Council's complaints process which is <a href="https://example.com/here/">here</a>.

Under that process and as part of the Council's work on standards and accountability, an Archive Note is permanently attached to the article which links to the Adjudication. The Press Council's process does not require the removal of the article although an Adjudication Panel can call for removal of it."
