What have been the greatest challenges for the media covering the Trump presidency?

The blizzard of daily news, and the difficulty in defining what matters and what doesn't.

Is the US media more divided and more partisan at the close of his first term?

The mainstream media – so-called – hasn't shifted throughout. The President has exploited and amplified biases, to maximum effect. Fox and Facebook have taken care of the rest.

If Trump wins a second term, what should the media do differently or what can the media do better?

Hold a steady course. Distinguish between the consequential and the rhetorical. Try to avoid talking about the President's state of mind, and resist being drawn in by his manipulations. Talk instead about the many variations of American voters, and the issues that matter to them most.
