AVAILABLE TO COMMENT: November bushfires

The bushfires that have ravaged the east coast of Australia this week have been unprecedented, with authorities sharing concerns for the coming weeks and months leading into summer as they work to assess and remedy the damage. A range of Griffith University experts in the field of technology and science are available to comment on bushfire impacts and potential mitigation strategies. Dr Johanna Nalau: *climate adaptation and disaster risk management*; Professor Darryl Jones: *ecology/environmental impacts*; Professor Catherine Pickering: *botanical ecology*; Dr Tony Matthews: *urban planning*; Professor David Tuffley: *AI and predictive mapping for disaster management*.

Genetic analysis suggests wise bin chickens tamed, sacrificed to Egyptian God

New genetic research into the mummification of ibises found in Egyptian catacombs has shed light on how Ancient Egyptians obtained millions of the 'wise' birds to sacrifice annually. The research, led by Griffith University, investigated historical suggestions that Sacred Ibis were farmed on an industrial scale in order to provide the God of Wisdom Thoth with millions of sacrificed birds each year. Mitogenomic analyses by the team revealed high genetic diversity among the mummified ibises from various sites. This suggests that mass-scale farming was unlikely and instead supported the possibility that temple priests and locals were able to tame and increase wild populations each year.

Are we overestimating lifetime cancer risks?

The method employed in Australia to calculate the lifetime risks of cancer diagnosis and mortality overestimates these risks, especially for men, according to the authors of research published today by the [*Medical Journal of Australia*](#). The Australian Institute of Health and Welfare (AIHW), like many cancer registries, calculates cumulative risk from cross-sectional data to estimate lifetime risks of cancer diagnosis and mortality. Researchers including Sunshine Coast-based Griffith School of Medicine Senior Lecturer Dr Thanya Pathirana and led by Dr Anthea Bach from West Moreton Hospital and Health Service and Dr Kelvin Lo from Westmead Hospital, analysed publicly available annual AIHW data on age-specific cancer incidence and mortality – for breast cancer, colorectal cancer, prostate cancer, melanoma of the skin, and lung cancer – and

all-cause mortality in Australia, between 1982 and 2013.

Addressing climate risks can improve tourism, communities and environment

A Griffith researcher has shown how systems thinking can aid tourism and climate change decision-makers in identifying and testing adaptation measures that will benefit tourism industries and destinations more broadly, including the local community and natural environment. Johanna Loehr, a PhD candidate within Griffith's Department of Tourism, Sport and Hotel Management and the Griffith Institute for Tourism, conducted the study into reducing climate risks destination-wide, which has been published in the *Journal of Sustainable Tourism*. Ensuring the tourism sector plays a role in a response to climate change will be crucial to ensure it can act as a truly sustainable development option for SIDS, Loehr said. "The system provides a novel tool for understanding climate risk reduction within destinations as a holistic system and based on this understanding, destination trade-offs and policy recommendations of how these may be minimized are highlighted."

Griffith research to help tourism operators reduce carbon emissions

Griffith University researchers are leading a project to help tourism operators worldwide reduce their carbon emissions. Professor Susanne Becken and Dr Rawan Nimri from the Griffith Institute for Tourism have been commissioned by EarthCheck, the world's leading scientific benchmarking, certificatory and advisory group for sustainable travel and tourism, to update its greenhouse gas emissions database and accounting tool. Dr Nimri said the project would help tourism operators understand how to address climate change measures and the actions that can be undertaken to help the industry respond to climate risks and opportunities.

Mushroom extracts could offer an immune cell boost

Researchers have found that a combination of mushroom extracts is able to enhance immune cell responses that could ultimately help to boost the immune system, offering protection from attack by pathogenic microbes and from the harmful effects of environmental toxins and carcinogens. Associate Professor Joe Tiralongo from Griffith University's Institute for Glycomics led the research, which has been patented and now published in *PLOS ONE*. A key characteristic of mushroom polysaccharides (polymers of sugar) that elicit an immune modulating response is that they are rich in beta-glucans and low in alpha-glucans. Mushrooms contain a variety of constituents that are important for supporting health, but the beta-glucans (polymers of glucose linked in a specific manner) are particularly important for supporting immune function.

Researchers discover potential therapeutic approach to treat ME / CFS

Researchers have discovered the pharmacological drug, Naltrexone, significantly restored the function of faulty receptors associated with myalgic encephalomyelitis, also known as Chronic Fatigue Syndrome (ME/CFS). Researchers from the National Centre for Neuroimmunology and Emerging Diseases (NCNED), Menzies Health Institute Queensland, Griffith University led the research, which has been published in *Frontiers in Immunology*. These receptors are widely found in the body and implicated in symptoms and onset of this illness. Importantly, the current groundbreaking research has used Naltrexone (an opiate) to restore the function of these faulty receptors in the immune cells from ME/CFS patients.

Research estimates value of impact national parks have on mental health

National parks worldwide are worth about \$8.7 trillion (\$US6 trillion) a year in the improved mental health of their visitors, according to initial estimates published by a team of Griffith University researchers. The Nature Communications study was jointly funded by Griffith University, Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service and Parks Victoria. Using a concept called quality-adjusted life years, which measured a person's ability to carry out the activities of daily life free from pain and mental disturbance, the researchers estimated the economic value of national parks using data collected from a representative sample of the Australian population in the states of Queensland and Victoria (19,674). They used these data to estimate the value for the whole of Australia and globally and found a direct link between visits to protected areas and individual

mental health. For Australia, the team estimated the annual health services value of Australia's national parks was around \$145 billion (\$US100 billion) a year.

Griffith Duo to equip women entrepreneurs in Latin America with digital business skills

Women in Ecuador and Mexico will receive online business training as part of a new project being led by Griffith University researchers that aims to increase the success rate of women entrepreneurs in Latin America. There are high rates of entrepreneurship among women in Ecuador and Mexico, but their businesses often struggle with unprofitability and have lower growth expectations compared to women in other regions and men in general. Dr Catheryn Khoo-Lattimore and Dr Elaine Yang, from the Griffith Institute for Tourism, hope to change this by running a series of training workshops in early 2020. The project aims to provide six cohorts of 20 women tourism entrepreneurs with tourism business and digital skills that will increase their ability to meet market needs.
