Introduction

- By submitting a TOP 5 Residency application, you agree to be bound by the Terms and Conditions of the Competition. The Terms and Conditions governing the Competition include these General Terms and Conditions, the Schedule to these General Terms and Conditions and any instructions relating to the Competition on the TOP 5 Website.
- 2. Any capitalised terms used in these General Terms and Conditions have the meaning given in the Schedule, unless stated otherwise. In the event of any inconsistency between the Schedule to the Terms and Conditions (Schedule) and these General Terms and Conditions, the Schedule will take precedence.
- 3. The ABC may in its absolute discretion refuse to award a residency to any entrant who fails to comply with these Terms and Conditions.

Entry Restrictions

4. Eligibility to enter a TOP 5 Residency application is subject to the Entry Restrictions. An entrant of the Competition must be an individual and not a company or organisation. Directors, immediate family members, employees and contractors of the ABC are not eligible to enter. Immediate family members, employees and contractors of the USYD, UMELB & the Australia Council for the Arts (AC) judges and short listers are not eligible to enter.

Competition Period

 Applications for the TOP 5 Residency will be conducted during the Competition Period. Any entry received after the expiry of the designated period will be deemed invalid. No responsibility is accepted for late, lost, delayed or misdirected entries. The period of the competition is from 8.30am AEST 31/03/23 to midnight AEST 14/05/22.

Entry Method

6. To apply for the TOP 5 Residency, applicants must enter in accordance with the Entry Method (and any other entry details provided by the Promoter on the Website) during the Competition Period. All applications are to be registered online via Submittable.

Maximum Number of Entries

7. Entrants can enter the TOP 5 Residency Competition once per calendar year and this entry must individually meet the requirements in the Schedule and are subject to the Entry Restrictions. Applicants can enter for more than one residency if they meet the requirements of the different categories, and previously non-successful applicants are encouraged to reapply the following year/s.

Judging Details

8. Five entrants from *Science*, five from *Arts* and five from *Humanities* - whose application is judged by the ABC'S panels of judges to be the most outstanding, and with demonstrated potential (and any judging criteria set out in Judging Details of the Schedule) will win one of the designated places in each of the residency.

The Promoter and its panel of judges may, in their absolute discretion, decline to award any or all places in the residency, including where the judges determine that the entry is not of publication standard. Chance plays no part in determining the residency winners. Decisions of the ABC and its panel of judges are final and will be binding on each person who applies, and no correspondence will be entered into.

Prize

9. The Residencies will be awarded as specified in the Schedule. The Prize values are approximated based on the value of accommodation, domestic flights and full time working at the ABC, are in Australian dollars and are correct as at the time of the commencement of the Competition Period. The ABC accepts no responsibility for any variation in the Prize value.

Prize Restrictions

- 10. Unless otherwise specified in the Schedule, the ABC will not be responsible for any additional costs associated with use of the Prize. The Prize winner (and, if applicable, their guest(s)) is responsible for all costs associated with using the Prize including (if applicable), expenses with respect to food and beverages, travel and medical insurance costs and spending money.
