Optional: Glitter Glue, Feathers

Step by Step:



- 1. Cut a semi-circle from the top and bottom of the paper plate
- 2. Cut out holes for the eyes
- 3. Use the paper plate offcuts to make a beak
- 4. Decorate and colour your owl mask
- 5. Glue down the beak and feathers
- 6. Poke a hole through each side of your mask
- 7. Thread the string through the hole and tie your owl mask around your face!
