

ABC Brand Naming Conventions

To ensure consistency, this quick reference guide will help you when using our brand names verbally or in writing. This does not list all ABC brands but highlights most used brands.

The simple rule of thumb: If the logo is in uppercase, the written copy follows.

ABC ME: uppercase logo/uppercase in copy. **ABC listen:** lowercase on listen/lowercase in copy.

Written
ABC TV
ABC TV and ABC iview
All letters in uppercase.
Never to be referred to as ABC1.

ABC iview and TV Plus

Written
ABC iview
ABC iview and ABC TV Plus
Never use a capital V on ABC iview.
ABC iview must always be used with ABC in front of iview.

Written
ABC listen
Always use lowercase, never use capital L on listen.
ABC must always be used in front of listen.

ABC NEWS
All letters in uppercase.
ABC must always be used in front of NEWS.

ABC NEWS RADIO
All letters in uppercase.
ABC must always be used in front of NEWS RADIO.

ABC Kids
ABC must always be used in front of Kids.
Use capital K on Kids.

ABC must always be used in front of Kids.
Use capital K on Kids.
Never use capital L on listen.

ABC must always be used in front of Family.

ABC Entertains and ABC iview
ABC must always be used in front of Entertains.

Written
ABC Radio PERTH
'Radio' is always title case.
The ABC capital city location is always uppercase.

ABC Radio AUSTRALIA
'Radio' is always title case.
Australia is always uppercase.

ABC [LOCATION]
The ABC regional location is always uppercase.

All letters in lowercase.
Never use title case or uppercase.

triple j Unearthed

Written
triple j Unearthed

Always use lowercase for triple j.
Always use capital U on Unearthed.

Double J

Written
Double J

Always use title case.
Always use capital D on Double,
and a capital J.

ABC Radio National

Written
ABC RN

All letters in uppercase.
ABC must always be used in front
of RN.

ABC CLASSIC

Written
ABC CLASSIC

All letters in uppercase.
ABC must always be used in front
of CLASSIC.

ABC Country

All letters in title case.
ABC must always be used in front
of Country.

ABC Jazz

ABC Jazz

All letters in title case.
ABC must always be used in front
of Jazz.

ABC SPORT

Written
ABC SPORT

All letters in uppercase.
ABC must always be used in front
of SPORT.

ABC AUSTRALIA

All letters in uppercase.
ABC must always be used in front
of AUSTRALIA.

ABC iview AUSTRALIA

Never use a capital V on ABC iview.
AUSTRALIA in uppercase.
