Paying Board

Focus Questions

Discuss the BTN High story as a class and record the main points of discussion. Students will then respond to the following:

1. Why might parents or carers want teenagers to pay board? Include your own experiences if relevant.
2. Do you think teenagers should pay board if they can afford to? Provide reasons.
3. Why do you think young adults are living at home for longer?
4. At what stage in life should teenagers or adults start contributing to household finances?
5. What strategies do you use to be financially responsible? Is there room for improvement?

Activities

- In groups, discuss whether you think teenagers should pay board. Include your experiences, or if it's a discussion you've had with your family.
- Create a weekly budget plan. Record your spending expenses, saving targets, and how much board you could contribute to your family if required.
- Should teenagers pay board? Host a class debate.
