## Response from a Seven spokesperson:

As you have noted, the 7NEWS story stated that "some residents are terrified." This assessment was based on interviews conducted by Evan Batten, who interviewed residents in the community. Vox pops were done to validate these sentiments. While not all of these interviews may have been included in the final cut of the story, they informed our understanding of the situation.

Our reporting does not suggest that Martin Saunders is currently a danger to the public, but rather covers the concerns primarily from those living in the community, as well as the mother of the child.
