Episode 1 – Captain Feathersword Has the Hiccups

Caterina, Simon, and John are having trouble understanding Captain so they call on Dr. Knickerbocker for help – demonstrating problem solving and the importance of getting help when needed.

Episode 2 – Jump Like a Kangaroo

Simon invites children to actively participate and join in on the jumping frenzy. Then join Evie and Lucia for Wiggly World of Dance for some beautiful ballet dancing.

Episode 3 – Wiggly Sing-Along Day

Get ready for Sing-Along Day in Wiggle House! Throughout the episode, The Wiggles emphasise the importance of engaging with nursery rhymes and invite children to sing and dance along at home too.

Episode 4 – Express Yourself

The Wiggles embark on an exciting journey of exploring emotions. Seeking guidance, they turn to Dr. Feelings for advice on how to express and manage their emotions effectively.

Episode 5 – Building with Blocks

Lucia and Caterina are playing with blocks, but they keep falling over. They seek help from Connie Struction, emphasising problem-solving and teamwork while ensuring plenty of fun is had along the way.

Episode 6 – Playtime Fun

John, Evie, Caterina, and Captain engage in imaginative play with their Wiggly dolls but encounter a challenge when the dolls feel tired and sore. Seeking help, they reach out to Dr. Lynn Burr.

Episode 7 – Music with Anthony

Embark on a musical journey with Anthony as he rocks his guitar. The Wiggles embrace their love for music, inviting children to join a music lesson where they'll explore the creation of various musical sounds.

Episode 8 – Recycling Day

The Wiggles engage in creative crafting and afterwards they face the challenge of overflowing recycle bins. They seek assistance from their friend Rob Ish, emphasising the importance of recycling.

Episode 9 – Wiggle Bay

Episode 11 – Let's Go Riding with Ponso

Join Lachy and Ponso the Pony on an exciting adventure and learn about the importance of instructing Ponso to go slow. But when Captain and Evie mistakenly say, "go fast," chaos ensues.

Episode 12 – Storytime with Lachy and Simon

Lachy and Simon join The Wiggles for story time, renowned for their exceptional storytelling skills, they encounter an unexpected problem. William Shakespeare helps them navigate the challenges they face.

Episode 13 – Wags Can't Stand Still!

Tsehay challenges Lachy, Lucia, and Wags to stand like statues, but Wags can't seem to stay still. They seek help from Dr. Kay Nine, encouraging problem-solving and teamwork.

Episode 14 – Lucia's Favourite Doll

Join The Wiggles for a celebration of music and imagination as they teach patience while doll Curly Sue gets repaired. Dance and sing with Lucia and her cherished Curly Sue.

Episode 15 – Pull a Funny Face

Caterina, John and Captain demonstrate the importance of friendship, compassion and problem solving when they discover Tsehay is feeling a little sad.

Episode 16 – Evie's Favourite Band

The Wiggles discuss their favourite things, and Evie contacts the manager of her favourite band to arrange a performance by The Carrot Sticks. Then be inspired by the World of Dance with an enchanting ballet.





Episode 17 – Marty the Human Party

It's a frosty morning and John faces a challenge—he's lost his strength. Tsehay suggests seeking help from Marty the Human Party, emphasising problem solving and teamwork.

Episode 18 – Baby Dorothy Won't Sleep

The Wiggles face a challenge when baby Dorothy won't fall asleep. Seeking help from Captain Feathersword, they learn about the power of teamwork, problem-solving, and the importance of sleep.

Episode 19 – John's Baby Nephew

Children learn the importance of recognising and addressing health concerns, empathy and understanding when baby Lenny visits The Wiggles, and they discover he has a temperature.

Episode 20 - Captain Feathersword Can't Sing

The Wiggles tackle singing lessons, explore the letter T, engage in counting activities, and help Captain find his quiet voice with the help of Lachtavia Larynx.

Episode 21 – The Toy and Fairy Parade

The Wiggles are playing with their favourite toys and singing a song all about them! The child viewer is invited to bring along their own cherished toy and join in the musical fun, promoting imaginative play.

Episode 22 – Pirate Dancing

The Wiggles and Captain Feathersword embark on an exciting pirate dance adventure! Encouraging children to join in and dance like pirates, promoting physical activity and coordination.

Episode 23 – The Wiggles Lose Their Wiggle!

Paloma the Mermaid is visiting today, but The Wiggles seem to have lost their Wiggle. They seek help from energetic Tsehay, demonstrating the importance seeking help when faced with challenges.

Episode 24 – Blow Me Down

An amusing challenge arises when saying "blow me down" makes The Wiggles and Captain tumble over. This episode encompasses imaginative play, problemsolving and comedic elements for children to enjoy.



Episode 25 – Simon Is Echoing

Simon finds himself echoing everything he hears, leading to a challenge for Evie and Lucia. They turn to Sir Echo for assistance, seeking a solution to Simon's echoing predicament.

Episode 26 – The Captain Feathersword Hat Routine

With a focus on problem solving, The Wiggles attempt various dance moves to help the Captain catch his sword, highlighting the importance of trying different strategies to find a solution.
