

- 1. The number of content complaints received by the ABC during FY2025 that broadly identify pro-Israel and anti-Palestine concern - identified as complaining about the bias from a Palestine versus Israel perspective in outright numbers. If you don't collect this data can you please state why you have not.**

Of the 1,288 content issues about the Middle East conflict in 2024-25, **65% (843)** were allegations of bias or lack of balance.

The 843 complaints alleging bias/lack of balance were broadly:

- 50% (422)** claiming pro-Palestine/pro-Hamas/pro-Hezbollah/pro-Iran/anti-Israel bias
- 45% (378)** claiming pro-Israel/anti-Palestine/anti-Hamas/anti-Hezbollah/anti-Iran bias
- 5% (43)** claiming other forms of bias (eg pro-US, anti-Greens)

- 2. If possible to isolate, the content [relating to Israel Palestine] (article or otherwise) that generated the greatest number of complaints in FY25.**

The greatest number of complaints about a single piece of content related to Israel/Palestine in 2024-25 was 69 in relation to an Instagram reel about the Gaza Freedom Flotilla Group's mission to send an aid ship to Gaza.
