**A statement from an RSPCA Spokesperson**

RSPCA NSW can confirm that we have not received any cruelty reports of this nature.

In NSW, RSPCA NSW, Animal Welfare League NSW, and NSW Police are authorised to enforce the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 1979 (POCTAA). Anyone with evidence, including first-hand information of an alleged breach of POCTAA should lodge a cruelty complaint to one of these three agencies.

If RSPCA NSW receives or collects evidence of an alleged breach of POCTAA, we will act accordingly.
