Focus Questions

Discuss the BTN High story as a class and record the main points of discussion. Students will then respond to the following:

- 3. Do you trust the content you see online? Why or why not?
- 4. Does seeing a lot of bad news on social media have an impact on how you view the world and humanity? Explain your answer.
- 5. What can you do to avoid doomscrolling?
- 6. What can you do to protect yourself from bad news?

- 'Social media is full of negative news'. Do you agree or disagree with this statement? Write an essay to support your view.
