Response from Daily Mail AU Editor, Felicity Hetherington,

'It's ludicrous to suggest the article was antisemitic. It celebrated the Jewish community, used information already in the public domain, and was consistent with our history of society coverage,' Daily Mail Editor Felicity Hetherington said.

'I note the Press Council chose not to refer the complaint about the article for further consideration, stating, "it is considered unlikely that a breach of the Council's Standard of Practice has occurred."

'Perhaps the ABC should look closer to home. Last week, ABC presenter Jan Fran shared an offensive fake news post that ridiculed the Jewish community in Sydney's eastern suburbs and was publicly criticised for doing so.

'I also note the recent media coverage of video editor Elahn Zetlin, who quit the ABC after 15 years due to what he described as systemic anti-Israel bias within the public broadcaster.'
