Algal Bloom

Focus Questions

Discuss the BTN High story as a class and record the main points of discussion. Students will then respond to the following:

- 1. Briefly describe what an algal bloom is.
- 2. Name the species of algae that's mainly responsible for the recent algal bloom in South Australia.
- 3. What events are likely to have caused the algal bloom?
- 4. How is the algal bloom affecting sea life?
- 5. What effect can it have on people?
- 6. What impact has the algal bloom had on the economy?
- 7. South Australian Senator Sarah Hanson-Young is leading a senate inquiry into the algal bloom. What will this senate inquiry involve?

Activities

- Should the algal bloom be declared a natural disaster? Write an essay arguing your point of view.
- In small groups, create a national campaign to raise awareness of the algal bloom.
- Australia is home to tens of thousands of different species of algae.
 Choose one type of algae and address the following as a scientific fact sheet: scientific name, description, geographical location and interesting facts. Include a reference list.
