Late to the party but I saw your email about the climate advisory group and am wondering who would be best to speak to at a practical level about our building here in Southbank and the emissions it is creating as my understanding is that we don't have solar panels; we run air con 24/7 and we also have lights and televisions running 24/7.

There are so many other things that should be happening but aren't in this building:

There needs to be better education about mixed recycling etc (can't tell you how often I find paper in the rubbish bins and recyclable plastic in wrong bins too.) We also need recycling bins in areas other than kitchens as many people are simply too lazy to take their recyclable goods to the kitchen.

We should be encouraging the café on site to charge much more for coffees in takeaway containers and a bigger discount for keep cups.

We should have more low waste and recycling options. Ie we have no soft plastic recycling options in the building.

We should have terracycle bins – or at least have the bins for the waste we create ourselves here at ABC. I am regularly taking home old whiteboard markers to drop them in a terracycle box – we need to have at least one of these in the building – ideally one on each floor.
